OPERATION BACKPACK is a weekend feeding program working to alleviate childhood hunger in Topeka and to encourage children in need. To ensure the nutritional needs of children are met when school is not in session, the program provides a small sack of food for youth to take home for the weekend. The food sack contains a two-day supply of nutritional, kid-friendly snacks and single-serving size food items that are easy for youth to prepare. Volunteers discreetly distribute the food sacks at your school.

<u>TO QUALIFY</u>: Children must receive free or reduced lunches <u>AND</u> meet one other qualifying factor (see below). Eligibility will also be based on the availability of program funds. Priority determination will be given to those who are single working parents, foster parents, grandparent parents, and disabled parents. Postcards will be mailed if you are <u>NOT</u> approved for the program.
